



Run Things Run Club London Marathon Club Ballot

Athletics clubs associated with England Athletics are able to apply for club entries to the London Marathon. The number of entries given to each club is based on the number of England Athletics first claim registered members over the age of 18.

To qualify for a place in the Run Things Run Club ballot each August in which we qualify for a place the next year, the following rules are to be adhered to:

- You must be a member of Run Things Run Club.
- You must have joined or renewed your annual EA first claim club affiliation to RTRC no later than the 30th June preceding the August club ballot in order to be eligible for the opportunity to enter the draw for our London Marathon club place.
- You should, when requested, submit your official London Marathon public ballot rejection to the Membership Secretary at RTRCmembership@gmail.com. The rejection email or letter must state your name clearly.
- Members who have previously been successful at gaining entry to run the London Marathon through the club ballot draw, will not be permitted to reapply for a club ballot place for a further two editions within which RTRC is granted a place.
- Club places granted by London Marathon provide guaranteed entry, but they are not free and must be paid in full by the winning Member.
- The winning Member running the marathon must run in club kit in order to represent RTRC.

The ballot will be advertised to Members via email and RTRC's Facebook group.

The Committee reserve the right to amend these rules and make exceptions if they agree the case is deserving. In such cases, the decision will be made public via email and on RTRC's Facebook group or by any other suitable means of communication. All decisions made by the Committee are final and cannot be appealed by any Member.
